### Transactional Panel Stockholder Activism: A View from All Sides

Panelists will discuss the legal issues that arise when a stockholder nominates, and succeeds in electing, candidates to a Board of Directors of a publicly held corporation, with insight from a member of the Delaware Court of Chancery and from legal and financial advisors. Panelists will discuss stockholder compensation of director candidates, disputes that arise in proxy fights and the fiduciary duty issues that counsel might confront after a stockholder candidate is elected as director.

## Litigation Panel Coping with Conflict

Conflict of interest transactions are a perennial staple of corporate litigation. In the last year, the Delaware Supreme Court and Delaware Court of Chancery have provided significant guidance concerning transactions involving: (1) conflicts between the controlling and minority stockholders, (2) conflicts between directors and officers and the stockholders and (3) investment banker and other advisor conflicts. Panelists will discuss these developments with an eye to advising parties negotiating a transaction that may involve conflict of interest and attacking or defending a conflict transaction in litigation.

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
