"I am honored to be part of this program designed to increase LGBT involvement," Eric said. "This appointment is a unique opportunity to combine two of the three great passions in my life - being a business attorney and advancing the cause of the LGBT community (with the third, though most important, being my family)."

Eric joins the 2015-2017 Envoy class, further expanding his ABA roles which already include co-editor of *Deal Points* (the M&A Committee newsletter) and vice-chair of the Private Equity and Venture Capital Committee.
