

Frank Biondi Honored for Contributions to Delaware with DSCC Marvel Cup Award

Wilmington, DE (January 12, 2016) - Last evening, the Delaware State Chamber of Commerce presented the prestigious Josiah Marvel Cup Award to retired Morris, Nichols, Arsht & Tunnell LLP partner O. Francis "Frank" Biondi.

Frank played an integral role in developing Delaware's Financial Center Development Act of 1981, serving as lead author of the legislation and ushering the seminal banking bill through to passage. The legislation greatly impacted the state, being credited with transforming Delaware's economy and opening the door for national banks and credit card companies to start operations in Delaware.

The DSCC's highest honor, the Marvel Cup Award was established in 1951 to recognize a "Delawarean who has made an outstanding contribution to the state, community or society."
