3. The helpful Delaware Public Benefit Corporation Conversion Checklist summarizes the necessary steps for a traditional corporation to become a public benefit corporation (PBC) in Delaware. A PBC is similar to a traditional corporation, but has more requirements, including obligations to pursue one or more public benefits and to operate in a manner that considers the interests of those materially affected by its conduct.
